PROJECT OVERVIEW

We host service projects for Alaskan residents who camp on the Cook Inlet beaches at the Kenai and Kasilof Rivers during the height of Salmon fishing season. Our ministry approach is gentle servanthood and need-meeting through various methods: Kids' Clubs, Bounce Houses, Prayer Walking, Traffic Control, Trash Pick-up and serving free hot dogs, water, and hot beverages. We engage the public in this secular forum through servant evangelism. This is "Beach Reach" Alaskan style!

WHAT TO BRING

- **MODESTY MATTERS** during our outreach - no leggings or revealing clothing.
- Warm Clothes – Alaska can have drastic temperature swings - plan to layer your clothing.
- Warm hat, scarf, and gloves/mittens
- GOOD RAIN GEAR
- House shoes/Crocs for indoor wear – Alaskans do not wear shoes inside the house
- Ear plugs if you are a light sleeper
- Cell phone & charger – it should work in most places around the state
- Bible and journal

- We recommend you book your flights so that all team members are arriving at the same time.
- Be sure to arrive/depart on designated days, and make sure you clearly understand your flight plan.
