## PROJECT OVERVIEW

We host service projects for Alaskan residents who camp on the Cook Inlet beaches at the Kenai and Kasilof Rivers during the height of Salmon fishing season. Our ministry approach is gentle servant hood and need-meeting through various methods: Kids' Clubs, Bounce Houses, Prayer Walking, Traffic Control, Trash Pick-up and serving free hot dogs, water, and hot beverages. We engage the public in this secular forum through servant evangelism. This is "Beach Reach" Alaskan style!

- Ages – Jr. High, Sr. High, College, Adult, and Seniors
- Individuals, Married Couples, Families, and Groups

**Groups with participants under the age of 18 must have guardians/leaders accompanying under-aged children/youth. Direct supervision must be maintained at all times.**

## WHAT TO PACK?!

**MODESTY MATTERS - no leggings or revealing clothing.**
